<sup>1</sup> Translator's note: CMI stands for Engineering Master Curriculum, which is a particular kind of Bachelor degree.

This degree has been recently implemented in France and is based on the model of the **Masters of Engineering** as offered in most well recognised international universities. A CMI curriculum is built on the association of **Education-Research-Enterprise**. The lecturers and laboratory members work together with private enterprises over the 5 years of this curriculum; a CMI curriculum is always affiliated to a well-established laboratory (both at the national and international scale) and involved in partnerships with private enterprises.

Starting right from the first year, projects and internships represent a great part of the curriculum, along with special activities intended to place students in specific contexts, combining scientific specialisation and personal development. An international mobility (a semester abroad) is also part of such a programme.
